**Directions to the Performing Arts Center:** East Central High School, 1 Trojan Lane, St. Leon, IN 47012. Conveniently located 15 miles east of Batesville, IN & 30 miles west of Cincinnati, OH off of Interstate 74.

Take Exit 164 St. Leon/Lawrenceburg off Interstate 74. Go north on IN-1. Turn left at first 4-way stop onto Highway 46. Continue west on 46 until you cross the I-74 overpass. Take an immediate left on Trojan Lane. East Central is on your left.

Take Exit 164 St. Leon/Lawrenceburg off Interstate 74. Go north on IN-1 & continue north at the 4-way stop onto Highway 46. Drive half mile. Turn right on Church Lane. Church is on left.

# SPEAKER

**Immaculee Ilibagiza** was born in Rwanda and studied Electronic and Mechanical Engineering at the National University of Rwanda. Her life transformed dramatically in 1994 during the Rwanda genocide when she and seven other women huddled silently together in a cramped bathroom of a local pastor's house for 91 days! During this horrific ordeal, most of Immaculee's family was brutally murdered, but she survived to share the story and her miraculous transition into forgiveness and a profound relationship with God.

Immaculee's first book, *Left to Tell; Discovering God Amidst the Rwandan Holocaust* quickly became a New York Times Best Seller. It has been adopted into the curriculum of dozens of high schools and universities, including Villanova Univ., which selected it for the 2007-08 "One Book Program", making *Left to Tell* mandatory reading for 6,000 students.

She has appeared in numerous media including 60 Minutes, CNN, EWTN, The Aljazeera Network, The New York Times, USA Today, Newsday, and many other domestic & international outlets. She has been recognized and honored with numerous humanitarian awards.

Today Immaculee is regarded as one of the world's leading speakers on peace, faith, and forgiveness. She has shared her universal message with world dignitaries, school children, multinational corporations, churches, & at many conferences.
